Sand Themes: Free Form or Wildlife

Divisions: Elementary-Middle School or High School-Adult **Sand Plots:** \$300 entry fee with up to 15 members per team.

Each 15' x 15' plot will be mounded with sand prior to the event.

Bring spades, shovels, buckets and trowels to create your winning sculpture.

Arrive at 8:00 a.m. the morning of the event to be assigned your plot on a first-come/first-serve basis at the check-in table.

Sand Sculpting Competition Requirements

Sand Sculpting Rules:

- Sand must be from within your plot, adjacent walkways and beach.
- Teams may not combine sites.
- Teams are not allowed to begin or alter their plot before 9 a.m.
- Plots must be clear except for the sand sculpture at 1 p.m. for the judging. This includes tools, trash, personal items and forms.
- Forms may be used during construction, but may NOT be incorporated structurally into the castle.
- Natural materials found on the beach such as shells, seaweed and twigs are allowed, but may be decorative only and not structural.
- Each team must provide their own tools, such as: trowels, spades, shovels, spatulas, brushes, large spoons, rakes, brooms, buckets, garbage cans and wood forms.
- Teams must provide containers for carrying water for sand sculptures.

Sand Sculpture Judging:

Judges will be identified on the day of the event by Official Judge medallions.

Two plot themes to choose from are: Free Form - Wildlife

Sand sculptures will be judged from all sides. Judging criteria for each division and theme will be:

Originality - Technical Difficulty - Artistic Execution - Carving/Sculpture Technique
